Toltecali Visual Arts Classes will be implementing a fresh educational strategy. In addition to obtaining traditional skills in painting, drawing, printmaking, ceramic, and conceptual art, the program will be teaching its' new and existing classes with a holistic approach that will encompass history and art history, philosophy and consciousness, and music and nutrition. This instruction, rooted in traditional indigenous culture will allow for a variety of processes, making learning accessible to more students. These methods are well-developed and established within Native and many international cultures but are only recently practiced within Western culture. The relationship between artist and student will be an exchange of information with both learning from each other so that everyone's experiences are validated.

## Visual Arts Workshops

### RUTH BUENTELLO, INSTRUCTOR DRAWING/PAINTING

This class will teach students to organize and create by experiencing and manipulating drawing/painting media and organizing images with the elements and principles of design. Students will create expressive drawings & paintings using the elements of design.

This workshop will encompass holistic hands-on approach to environmental art beginning with the understanding of the healing properties of plants and herbs. Students will learn about art through to grow Indigenous plants through organic gardening. The work will document their newly acquired knowledge through drawings/paintings in sketchbooks.
